


TOWN OF BURNSVILLE  
Public Hearing  
August 7, 2014

The Town Council, with Mayor Theresa Coletta and members Judy Buchanan, Ron Powell, and Bill Wheeler present, held a public hearing at 5:45 on Thursday, August 7, 2014, in the Town Hall. Councilor Ruth Banks was absent due to illness. Also in attendance were town staff members Brian Buchanan, Leslie Crowder, Anthony Hensley, Jeanne Martin, and George Nero; town attorney Heather Hockaday, and visitors Lucy Doll, Lori Famularo, Dean Gates, Jody Higgins, Rhonda Higgins, Ginger Johnson, Jeannette Roland, Wanda Proffitt, and others. Mayor Coletta, who presided, opened the hearing.

The purpose of the hearing was to consider the question of annexing a 1.576 acre parcel that lies contiguous to the town's western limits, that is owned by High Five Hospitality Holdings. Annexation was requested by petition filed pursuant to G.S. 160A-31.

Noting there were no comments, Bill Wheeler made a motion to close the public hearing. Ron Powell seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
