

TOWN OF BURNSVILLE
Public Hearing
June 5, 2014

The Town Council, with Mayor Theresa Coletta and members Judy Buchanan, Ruth Banks, and Bill Wheeler present, held a public hearing at 5:45 on Thursday, June 5, 2014, in the Town Hall. Councilor Ron Powell was absent due to family illness. Also in attendance were town staff members Brian Buchanan, Leslie Crowder, Anthony Hensley, Jeanne Martin, and George Nero; town attorney Heather Hockaday, and visitors Bill Baker, Denise Cook, Denise Dickens, Dean Gates, Ron Hancock, Jody Higgins, Rhonda Higgins, Ginger Johnson, Rhea Ormand, Wanda Proffitt, and others. Mayor Coletta, who presided, opened the hearing.

The purpose of the hearing was to consider the question of annexing property owned by High Five Hospitality Holdings on the contiguous to the town's western limits, requested by petition filed pursuant to G.S. 160A-31.

Steve Isaacs, owner of Fast Stop Markets, spoke in favor of the annexation, advising that he plans to build a definite asset for the community.

Wanda Proffitt spoke in favor of the annexation, mentioning that this is a great opportunity for new business and investments in Burnsville and Yancey County.

Noting there were no further comments, Ruth Banks made a motion to close the public hearing. Bill Wheeler seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
