Special Meeting
July 18, 2014

On July 18, 2014, the Town Council, with members Mayor Theresa Coletta, Ruth Banks, Judy Buchanan, Ron Powell and Bill Wheeler present, held a special meeting at the Burnsville Town Center. Also in attendance were staff members Anthony Hensley, Jeanne Martin and George Nero; Planning Board Chair Dean Gates, and visitor Jody Higgins. The Mayor called the meeting to order, stating that the purpose of the meeting was to consider an amendment to the sign ordinance and any other issue deemed appropriate by the Town Council.

Planning Chair Dean Gates told council that the Planning Board is recommending an increase in the size of freestanding signs in the C-2 district from 32 to 64 square feet. A public hearing will be necessary to consider this change.

Ron Powell moved to schedule a public hearing prior to the the August 7th meeting on a proposed amendment to the sign ordinance, which will increase the size of freestanding signs in the C-2 district. Ruth Banks seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

There being no further business, Judy Buchanan moved to adjourn. Ron Powell seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.
