

Burnsville Planning Board
Special Meeting
Thursday, September 24, 2015

The Burnsville Planning Board, with members Dean Gates, Kim Simpson, Harrison Tyner, Jeff Merck, Woody Ryan present held a Special Meeting on Thursday, September 24, 2015, in the Town Hall. Also in attendance town staff member Anthony Hensley and Town Council member Bill Wheeler. Dean Gates, who presided, called the meeting to order stating the purpose of the meeting was to make recommendation to Town Council concerning tattoo parlor ordinance.

- Approval of Minutes- Minutes from the regular meeting held on Thursday, August 20, 2015 and minutes from the special meeting held on Thursday, September 10, 2015 were available. Harrison Tyner made a motion to approve both set of minutes, Jeff Merck seconded and all agreed.
- Public Comment – There were no public comments.
- Harrison Tyner made a motion to submit Article 5 changes to Town Council, Kim Simpson seconded and all agreed.
- Dean Gates lead a discussion regarding tattoo parlor regulations with board members. Harrison Tyner made a motion to accept Town Councils recommendations to Article 8, with the following recommended changes:
 - 1) Article 8, Section 802(2)(d)(a): Section 1 and 2 should not be repealed. Section 1 should read as follows:

Be located or operated on any real property that is within 400 feet of any property that is zoned for residential purposes outside the hours of 10:00am and 8:00pm and closed on Sunday.
 - 2) Section 2 should not change.
 - 3) Section 3 should remain as is. Closed on Sunday.
 - 4) Section 802.1 (C3) should have the same regulation for tattoo parlors as C-2.

Jeff Merck seconded the motion and all agreed.

Harrison Tyner made a motion to adjourn, Kim Simpson seconded, meeting adjourned.
