Monday, April 25, 2019


The Town Council, with members Judy Buchanan, Isaac McCurry, and Bunnie McIntosh present, held a special meeting on Monday, April 15, 2019, at the Town Hall. Councilor Russell Fox attended the meeting via Skype. Also in attendance were Brian Buchanan, Leslie Crowder, Niles Howell, and Jeanne Martin. Mayor protempore Judy Buchanan, who presided, called the meeting to order, stating that the purpose of the meeting was to consider and possibly take action on matters related to the Town's FY 2019-2020 budget.

Mayor Theresa Coletta joined the meeting at this point.

Council focused on the Police Department budget, and Chief Brian Buchanan led a line-by-line review. He shared the logic behind ordering a new vehicle each year and advised the new car in this budget would replace a 2011 Crown Victoria that is currently driven by Officer Bryan Fields.

Consideration was then given to the Fire Department budget. Chief Niles Howell explained the rationale behind the figures reflected in each line.

There being no further business, Judy Buchanan moved to adjourn. Bunnie McIntosh seconded the motion, which carried.
