The Town Council, with members Mayor Theresa Coletta, Judy Buchanan, Russell Fox, Isaac McCurry, and Bunnie McIntosh present, held a special meeting on Monday, April 15, 2019, at the Town Hall. Also in attendance were Brian Buchanan, Leslie Crowder, and Jeanne Martin. The Mayor, who presided, called the meeting to order, stating that the purpose of the meeting was to consider and possibly take action on matters related to the Town's FY 2019-2020 budget.


Council focused on completion of the Administrative budget. After review of all administrative lines, particular attention was given to Community Promotions. Funding requests from each non-profit were available, and increases were discussed. It was generally agreed that the Public Art budget would be scaled back to an amount equal to the electric bill for the art installation planned for the western gateway.

Council discussed the mural project that has been undertaken by Rhea Ormond, who has been fund raising to cover her costs. Theresa Coletta moved to contribute \$500.00 from the Public Art line in the current budget to this project. Bunnie McIntosh seconded the motion, which carried.


Consideration was given to the parking lot lease with the Briggs Estate. Russell Fox agreed to talk with Staunton Norris about the unlit street lights on the lot.
