**Special Meeting**  
**Monday, May 14, 2018**

The Town Council, with members Mayor Theresa Coletta, Judy Buchanan, Russell Fox, Bunnie McIntosh and Shannon Peterson present, held a special meeting on Monday, May 14, 2018, at the Town Hall. Also in attendance were Leslie Crowder, Jeanne Martin and Ronnie Tipton. The Mayor, who presided, called the meeting to order, stating that the purpose of the meeting was to consider and possibly take action on matters related to the Town's FY 2018-2019 budget.


Council focused on completion of the General Fund budget. It was noted that lines needed to be added in the General Fund budget as well as the Water/Sewer budget to accommodate the expense of an administrator. Council directed that a letter be drafted to the Chamber of Commerce stating that the Town can no longer absorb the entire cost of labor for the Crafts Fair and asking that we share equally in that expense.

With a focus on the Water/Sewer fund budget, Council considered all capital projects, both ongoing as well as proposed. Water/sewer rates were discussed.


Employee increases were considered, and the general consensus was to adhere to the League of Municipalities' average state-wide increase of 2.25%.
